For over 95 years, Columbia Bank has been known for its steadfast community support. However, in 2004, we realized we simply wanted to do more. With a desire to make a stronger impact in the communities we serve, the Columbia Bank Foundation was born.

Since its inception, the Foundation has continued to grow in both size and scope. While our historic support has been sizable, the Foundation was further bolstered in 2018 as Columbia Financial Inc. executed an Initial Public Offering (IPO). By recognizing a corporate responsibility to give back, a contribution of 3,576,675 shares were made to the Columbia Bank Foundation. Through this added equity, the Columbia Bank Foundation has distributed over \$2.0 million each year to organizations in need.

Currently, the Columbia Bank Foundation takes a three-pronged approach to giving back. Through grants, sponsorships and charitable giving, as well as the Bank's Employee Sponsored Giving Program, the Foundation is able to touch the lives of many. This report provides a small glimpse into the large impact our Foundation has each day.

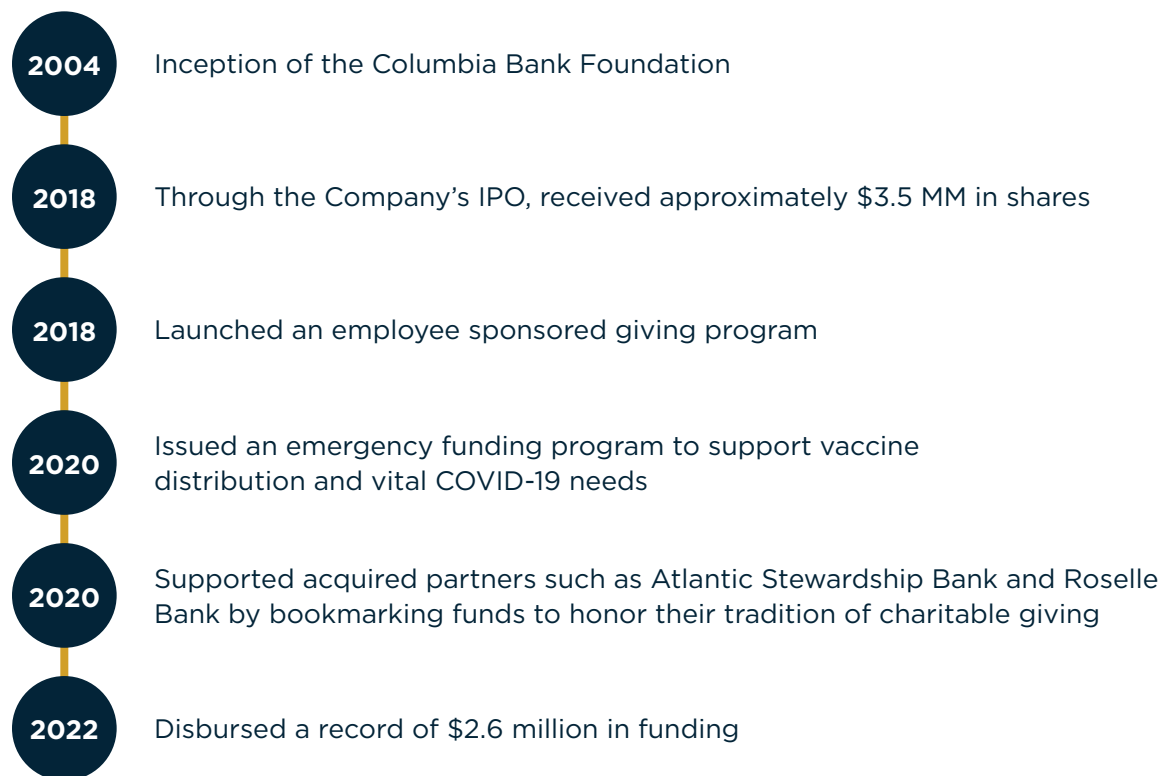

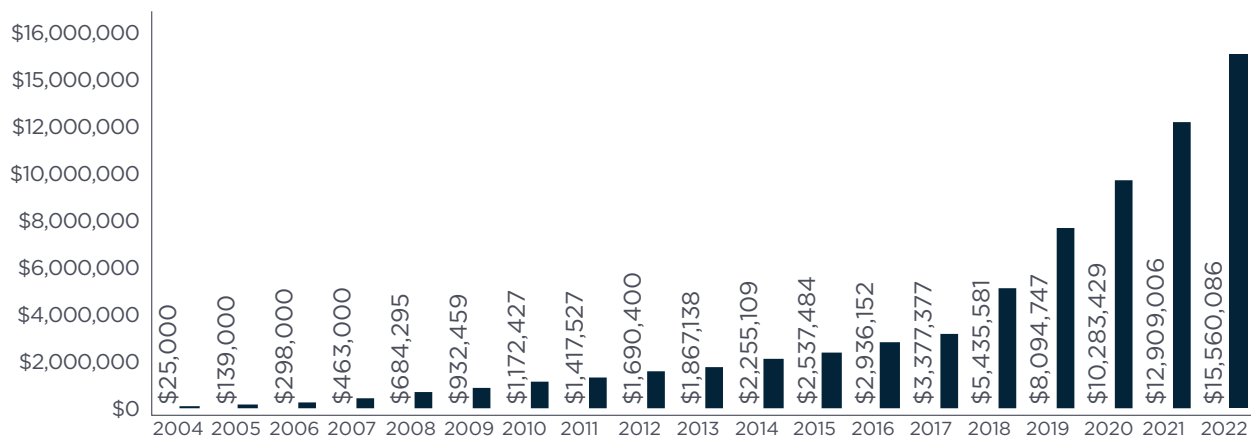

### Total Columbia Bank Foundation Disbursements Accumulated

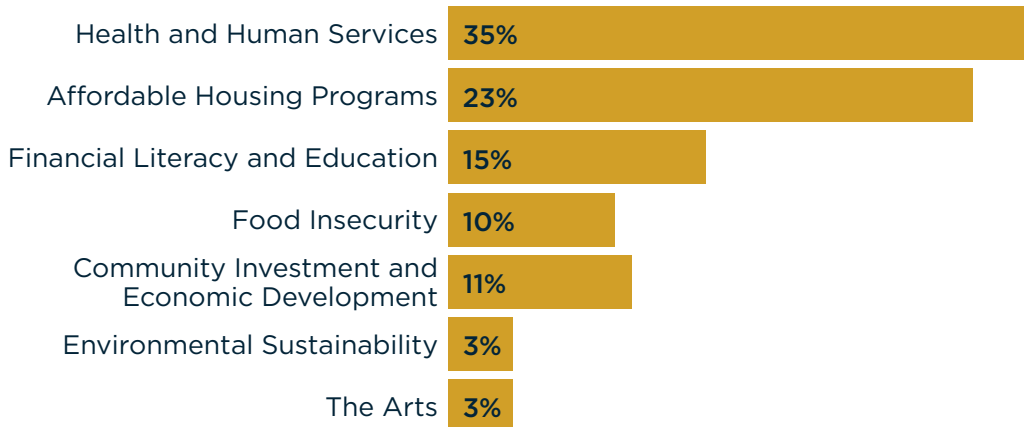

## 2022 Disbursements By Focus





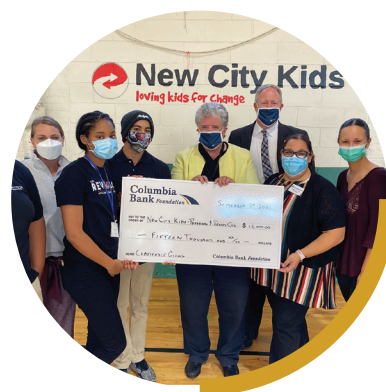
# Our Programs: Grants

The Columbia Bank Foundation's grant program allows local organizations to submit funding requests for initiatives that will create a meaningful impact. Grant requests are first reviewed for eligibility, then submitted to the Columbia Bank Foundation's Board of Directors for consideration. Our grant program allows us to learn more about the needs of our community, the support required to fulfill those needs and the desired results once implemented.

**Learn more about some of our 2022 grants below:**

## New City Kids

New City Kids offers after school programming for low-income youth. Through a grant of \$20,000, the Columbia Bank Foundation helped support their expansion to a second location in Paterson, New Jersey. In the new location, first through eighth graders will have access to academic and instrumental music instruction, while high school students will have the opportunity to be paid mentors and tutors. By surrounding them with a community of love and development, we hope to inspire transformation for the future.



## Greater Newark Conservancy

Through a grant of \$25,000, the Columbia Bank Foundation supported the Greater Newark Conservancy's Plot-it-Fresh program. This program aims to address food insecurity through a sustainable, urban garden. Through growing fresh produce, the garden makes healthy food available to the Newark community through partnerships with pantries and other free or low-cost distribution entities.

## NewBridge Services

NewBridge Services brings balance to people's lives through counseling, housing and education. Through a grant of \$25,000, the Columbia Bank Foundation supported construction costs for two individuals who are housing insecure. The tenants have been stably housed for over 10 years at the subject property and improvements will improve energy efficiency, insulation, siding and more.

# Our Programs: Employee Sponsored Giving

Our third major program reflects how giving back is deeply engrained in Columbia Bank's culture. In 2018, the Foundation launched its Employee Sponsored Giving Program which was designed for employees to nominate organizations for donations. Each year, employees submit organizations close to their hearts. Subsequently, the nominations are grouped by overarching mission and distributed each month for a vote. #### Wounded Warrior Project

The Wounded Warrior Project aims to honor and empower Wounded Warriors who incurred a physical or mental injury, illness or wound on or after September 11, 2001. Their vision is to foster the most successful, well-adjusted generation of wounded service members in the nation.

## How to Apply for a Grant

Before applying for a grant, please review the Columbia Bank Foundation guidelines for grant requests:

- The minimum grant amount request is \$5,000
- The Foundation Board reviews requests over \$5,000 to \$25,000 on a quarterly basis
- The Board will review one grant proposal per organization during a 12-month period
- Only completed grant proposals submitted electronically will be considered
- We understand that it's not ideal for all applicants to submit electronically, so we will make every effort to accommodate you if assistance is requested
