▶ **First Time Homebuyer Program**

The First-Time Homebuyer Program provides direct financial assistance to low- and moderate-income Burlington County residents to help with the purchase of a first home. Eligible applicants may receive a grant for up to \$10,000 in closing cost assistance, interest rate buy down assistance and \$15,000 towards their down payment.

▶ **HOME Investment Partnerships Program**

HOME is a flexible program designed to work in partnership with local nonprofit and/or for-profit groups to fund a wide range of activities that build, buy, and/or rehabilitate affordable housing for rent or homeownership.

▶ **Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG)**

Federal funds from Housing and Urban Development (HUD) are awarded as a grant to Burlington County to carry out a wide range of community development activities directed toward revitalizing neighborhoods, economic development, and providing improved community facilities and services.

These Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds may only be used to meet broad national objectives as follows:

- Benefiting low- and moderate-income persons
- Preventing or eliminating slums or blight
- Meeting other community development needs having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community and other financial resources are not available to meet such needs
